### **HAVING TROUBLE ONLINE? CYBER999, CYBERSECURITY MALAYSIA'S HELP CENTRE IS NOW ON ANDROID AND IOS SMARTPHONES.**

**THE CYBER999 APP IS LAUNCHED TODAY AND AVAILABLE FOR  
DOWNLOAD VIA APPLE STORE AND GOOGLE PLAY**

**KUALA LUMPUR, 10<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2014.** CyberSecurity Malaysia, the national cyber security specialist agency under the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI) today launched the **Cyber999 App**.

“**Cyber999 App** is a tool for Internet users to report cyber security incidents and online threats to the **Cyber999** Help Centre. It is **FREE, EASY-TO-USE** and suitable for smart phones users (iOS and Android). The Cyber999 App also contains advisories and tips on internet safety” Said Dr. Amirudin Abdul Wahab, the Chief Executive Officer of CyberSecurity Malaysia.

**He added that: “Cyber999 App** will transmit the cyber security incident reports made by the Internet users via a secured Internet connection to **Cyber999** incident handling team. Upon receiving the reports, the team will contact the users and assist them to resolve the incidents.”

Among incidents which are commonly reported to **Cyber999** are: Online Purchase Fraud, Phishing, Scams; Malware and Virus Infection; Spams; System Intrusion; Web Defacement and DDoS; Cyber Harassment; Defamatory, Seditious and Inappropriate Content. The public may report incidents and request for assistance in resolving their online problems via email, fax, online form, SMS and phone call.”

Dr. Amirudin added: “The Cyber999 App is the latest method of keeping in touch with the Cyber999 team and probably the fastest way to get Cyber999 emergency assistance for smart phone users who are always connected to the Internet. To Download the CYBER999 APP for iPhone, go to App Store for Apple iOS. or Android phones, go to Google Play. Search for Cyber999 and install.
