'TRUSTED & SECURED ECO SYSTEM' PROMOTES E-BUSINESSES AND MITIGATES MULTI-DIMENSIONAL CYBER SECURITY CHALLENGES

*Cyber Security Malaysia - Awards, Conference and Exhibition #CSMAACE14, to address national cyber security concerns
11-15 November 2014 at the Casuarina@Meru, Ipoh, Perak Darul Ridzuan*

IPOH, PERAK DARUL RIDZUAN (12 November 2014) – Cyber-attacks have become more frequent, more widespread, and more consequential. Cyber-attacks reduce the availability of information exchange and impair the ability of the information environment to support effective and efficient business processes. An insecure environment weakens the cyber ecosystem.

We need a 'trusted and secured ecosystem' to promote e-businesses and mitigate multi-dimensional cyber security challenges - known and emerging threats; thereby improving the reliability and resiliency of critical infrastructures and better assure privacy, business processes and government missions. A healthy cyber ecosystem would interoperate broadly, collaborate effectively in a distributed environment, respond with agility, and recover rapidly.

"Trusted and Secured Ecosystem" is the theme of the Cyber Security Malaysia - Awards, Conference and Exhibition 2014 (#CSMAACE14), organized by CyberSecurity Malaysia from 11 to 15 November 2014 in partnership with Perak State Government. The event is held at the Casuarina@Meru Hotel in Ipoh, Perak.

Incorporating several outstanding and interesting satellite events in addition to the main conference, awards and exhibition; the weeklong CSM-ACE 2014 is attended by more than 1000 local and international participants from among the most influential and innovative minds in the cyber security industry, the government as well as the education sector.

YB Datuk Dr. Ewon Ebin, Minister of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI) in his speech said, in today's highly connected digital era, the maintenance of a secure, resilient and trusted electronic operating environment that supports the digital economy is very important. "I am glad that CyberSecurity Malaysia, through CSM-ACE 2014, is addressing the need to have a Trusted and Secured ecosystem, as one of the key success factor for digital Malaysia." The Minister added.

CyberSecurity Malaysia is the National cyber security specialist agency under the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI). This is the first time that the CSM-ACE is held outside of Kuala Lumpur, with Perak being the first State to co-host and co-organise the largest cyber security summit in the country.

CSM-ACE is an annual event and this year the emphasis will be on securing e-business, as well as human capital's capability and capacity building. There is a series of cyber security training on various topics. More than

It was during the event that CyberSecurity Malaysia introduced the Malaysia Cyber Security Awards (MCSA). In 2010, CyberSecurity Malaysia launched the CSM-ACE brand name when it organised a 3-in-1 event comprising an industry Award (Malaysia Cyber Security Awards), a Conference, Exhibition and various satellite events involving international brands as well as local brands of ICT security seminar or conference.
