CYBERSECURITY MALAYSIA CONDUCTS TALKS ON CYBER SECURITY AWARENESS FOR EVERYONE (CyberSAFE) IN KOTA KINABALU

Kota Kinabalu: CyberSecurity Malaysia, the national cyber security specialist centre, under the purview of the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI), is in Kota Kinabalu again – this time to conduct **CyberSAFE Talk** in conjunction with the Malaysia Inovative 2010 (MI2010) Carnival at Universiti Malaysia Sabah.

Lt. Col. Husin Haji Jazri (Retired), CEO of CyberSecurity Malaysia explained that CyberSAFE is short for “Cyber Security Awareness For Everyone”, which is an outreach programme by CyberSecurity Malaysia with the objective of inculcating safe internet behaviours among Malaysians.

The CyberSAFE Talk is held from 2.45pm on 28th May 2010, at the Bankuasi Hall (Dewan Bankuasi), Level 1, Universiti Malaysia Sabah.

The talk is focus on computer/internet threats and how the hackers exploit weaknesses in computer systems and Internet. Participants will learn how hackers operate, and will get to know some of the popular hackers, their characters, and their expertise.

Other than conducting CyberSAFE programme, CyberSecurity Malaysia also provides training and certification services for information security practitioners as well as for those inspiring to be cyber security professionals.

“Our services also include Cyber999™ Help Centre, CyberCSI or Digital Forensics, Security Assurance, Security Evaluation and Certification using Common Criteria Standard, Information Security Management System (ISMS) guidelines, and Business Continuity Management.
