The attack...is sent as part of an HTML attachment with unsolicited emails claiming to be legitimate...

EBay Ordered to Pay \$61 Million in Sale of Counterfeit Goods

PARIS — EBay said it would appeal a French court's order that it pay 38.6 million euros (\$60.8 million) in damages to the French luxury goods company LVMH, the latest round in a longrunning legal battle over the sale of counterfeit goods on the Internet.

LVMH Moët Hennessy Louis Vuitton, a maker of high-end goods and fashion and luxury products, successfully challenged <u>eBay</u> for a second time in the French court, arguing that 90 percent of the Louis Vuitton bags and Dior perfumes sold on eBay are fakes.

The court ruled Monday that eBay, which earns a commission on the sales,


