A not-for-profit organisation under the purview of the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI), CyberSecurity Malaysia was officially launched by the Prime Minister of Malaysia on 20th August, 2007.

We will be celebrating our 10th anniversary this year, and this is the kind of recognition, that promotes positive behaviour and hence motivates us to do more in the future.
