Some of the notable speakers are W. Hord Tipton, (ISC)² Executive Director and US Department of Interior Former Chief Information Officer and Professor Jill Slay, Lab Director of the Australia Research Centre Forensic Computing Lab. and Lt. Col. Husin Jazri (R), the Chief Executive Officer of CyberSecurity Malaysia will also speak and present a paper at the conference.

Parents, teachers and children will also have free seminars and segments dedicated for them in order to generate public awareness of how to get empowered and protect themselves. As Husin points out, a lot of families today are connected to the Internet.

For this reason, the organisers of the event have dedicated parts of the event for the public. Open to the public are the Internet Safety Awareness Seminars on Child Issues, Internet Addiction, Social Networking, challenges to teachers and much more.

Husin said that cyber threats brought to modern day businesses and doorsteps were increasingly worrying with the rise of organised crime on the Internet.

“The malicious hackers of today are no longer the fun-seeking-teenager persona-typed-persons going on the Internet to prove that they can hack into computers of government agencies and organisations,” he said.

He said that these criminals were now organised borderlessly – spawning a new breed of organised criminals – e-mafia and even the traditional organised criminals were investing and branching out into the new illicit “franchise”.

Husin said that globally, billions of dollars were lost – some unnoticed and some dismissed and some remain unreported in order to protect public image and confidence and due to “embarrassment”.

“It’s all about the data, whether botnets, malware, blended threats, mobile threats or cyber warfare attacks. And CyberSecurity Malaysia expects data to drive cyber attacks for years to come,” said Husin.
