 interacting with digital services or products is essential for driving nationwide adoption
 and engagement.
- Unlocking the Potential of a Trusted Digital Malaysia: Building Digital Trust is key to fueling Malaysia's digital transformation. The discussions underscored how trust can enhance user confidence, promote innovation, and ensure the success of digital initiatives across the nation.

Chief Operating Officer CyberSecurity Malaysia, Roshdi Bin Haji Ahmad, said, "The focus on 'Building Trust in Malaysia's Digital Journey' is both timely and crucial. As we navigate an increasingly digital landscape, it is imperative that we establish a robust digital trust framework. By fostering a culture of trust grounded in ethical conduct, transparency, and accountability, leveraging cutting-edge technologies like blockchain and artificial intelligence will not only

enhance trust and security but also position Malaysia as a leader in the global digital economy."
